- ⇒ Heaven is where God is, and we will one day physically be there with God face to face with a "good, restored body" if we believe that Jesus Christ died for our sins and we want to be part of God's family.
- ⇒ We don't know where Heaven's exact physical location is. In the Bible it talks about an existing heaven which God made (Gen14: 19) . It also says God will make a new heaven and a new earth (Rev 21:2).
- ⇒ When we worship God as a group of people it is sometimes said to be like experiencing being at a small window that looks into heaven.
- ⇒ We are not capable of humanly knowing the full extent of such goodness, but if we take all the good things in the world and multiply them all together, it will be better than that.
- ⇒ We will meet fellow Christians from all ages in heaven and we will recognize them!
- ⇒ There is a lot we don't know about heaven. We are free to imagine what it might be like, but

need to be honest that we don't know a lot of the exact minute details.



Hell is real


- ⇒ Hell is where God is not, and where Satan and all who reject God will go after this life on earth.
- ⇒ The general indication of its nature is that it will be a place of great regret and anguish, with no end to that state of being.
- ⇒ As with heaven, we don't know Hell's exact physical location, and there is no indication that there will be any "comforts or necessities of life" there.
- → Once in hell in the life hereafter there is no escaping it forever.
- ⇒ Those who do finish up in hell, many may not have deliberately chosen it as their destination. But since they reject God or deny his existence, that will be their lot since there is only heaven or hell after this life.
- Ultimately we don't decide who goes to heaven or hell, but God will judge by what is in people's hearts and lives.

"Take and eat, this (bread) is my body which is given for you. Take and drink (wine), this is my blood (life) of the new covenant (agreement) which was given for you, for the forgiveness of your sins."
