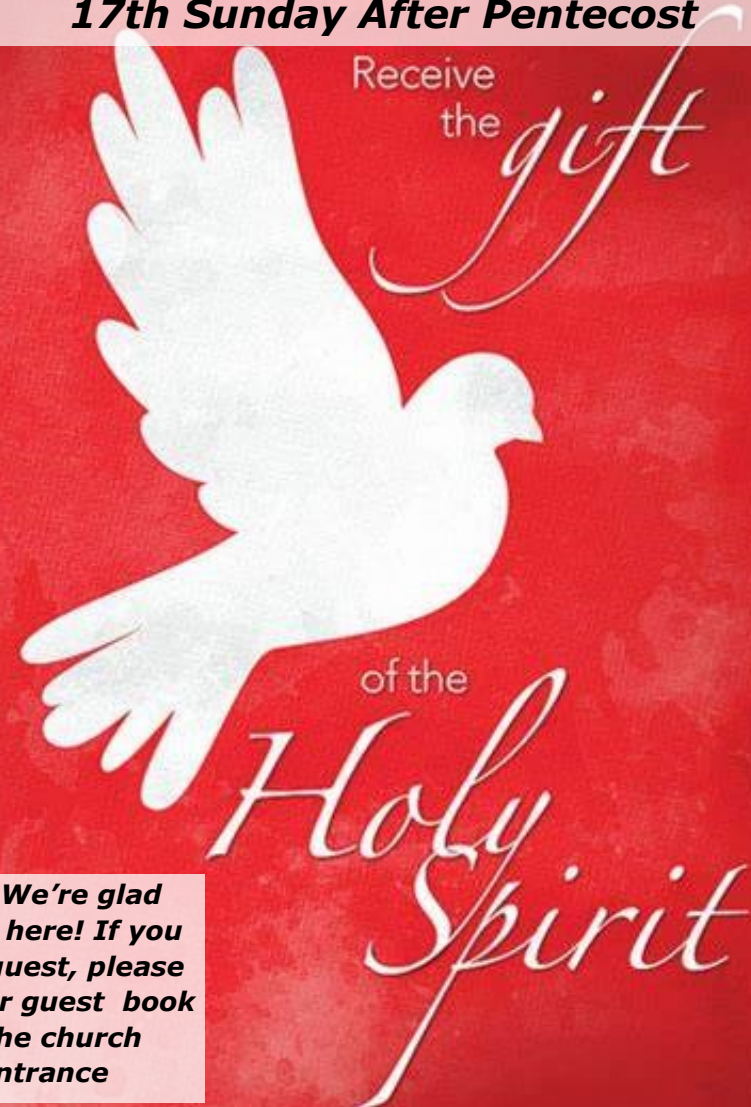

## General Notices

**THIS YEAR ...** the organisers at St James who collect for the Operation Christmas Child Shoebox appeal have decided not to collect as in previous years.

I have suggested another worthwhile charity called "Share the Dignity" which supports homeless women, women at risk or women experiencing domestic violence, right here in our local community.

Every year Share the Dignity have a "Handbag appeal". It's simple. First of all, choose a handbag/backpack in good condition that you no longer use, (can be new or preloved). Then, fill it with items including pads and tampons, personal hygiene products and everyday luxuries that would make a woman feel special, pop in a thoughtful note or Christmas card and show her someone cares. You have the power to make life better for a woman or girl experiencing homelessness or poverty this Christmas.

A brick refurbishing table has been built by Bob and will be positioned in the N E corner of Church yard. Stormfront Productions have been notified and will direct people to park cars between Hall and new shed.
